Under Yu's leadership, Ally Bridge Group has led or co-led investments in innovative life science companies with a total aggregate value of over \$6 billion.

Yu began his career in New York, then worked in Hong Kong for over two decades. Previously, Yu served as a managing director in Hong Kong at Sculptor Capital Management (formerly Och-Ziff Capital Management), a leading global hedge fund. Before that, Yu was a managing director at Goldman Sachs in Hong Kong where he worked nearly a decade, led several business units and played key roles in some of the most high-impact restructuring, IPO, and mergers and acquisitions transactions in Asia. Prior to Goldman Sachs, Yu worked at Moody's in New York and then Credit Suisse in London and Hong Kong.

As a global businessman active in the United States, Europe, and Asia, Yu remains passionate about art, history, and world cultures and is committed to enhancing diversity and multi-culturalism through art collection, business, and philanthropic activities. Yu serves as a board member of the Solomon R. Guggenheim Foundation in New York and the Fubon Art Foundation in Taiwan.
