Russ Artzt, a 1968 graduate of Queens College, is the executive chairman and head of research and development at Ringlead—a SaaS software company based in Melville, LI. His mission is to lead a process of innovation that empowers businesses to transform themselves. Ringlead’s data management platform makes this possible through visionary design and a continually expanding feature set.

Artzt previously led comparable product development efforts as co-founder and head of research and development of Computer Associates (CA Technologies)—the first billion-dollar software company, which was sold to Broadcom for \$18.9 billion in 2018. At Ringlead, as it was at CA, his goal is to build a true enterprise software company.
