

# Mr. David I. Weiner '76

David Weiner is a managing director and senior portfolio manager at Neuberger Berman, an employee-owned asset manager with more than \$300 billion in assets under management and thirty-six offices in twenty-two countries around the world. Mr. Weiner joined Neuberger Berman in 1994 after having worked at EM Warburg Pincus & Co., Delafield Asset Management, and First Manhattan Company, and has been a general partner at Neuberger since 1996. At Neuberger, he invests several billion dollars for individuals and institutional clients, primarily in domestic equities, as part of a group that includes Marvin and Charlie Schwartz, Richard and Taylor Glasebrook, and Queens College alumna and Queens College Foundation trustee Stephanie Stiefel.

Mr. Weiner graduated from Queens College with a BA in economics in 1976 and attended the Columbia



University Business School. He is a trustee of the Jewish Foundation for the Education of Women (JFEW), which provides educational grants to help women attend college. JFEW also funds programming at Queens College.
