**JAMES A. MITAROTONDA** is chairman, president, and chief executive officer of Barington Capital Group, L.P., a value-oriented activist investment firm that he founded in January 2000. Mitarotonda is an experienced public company director. He currently serves as a director of The Eastern Company and Rambus Inc. He has also served as a director of A. Schulman, Inc.; Avon Products, Inc.; OMNOVA Solutions, Inc.; The Pep Boys - Manny, Moe & Jack; The Jones Group; Griffon Corporation; Gerber Scientific, Inc.; Register.com, Inc.; Sielox, Inc.; and Ameron International Corporation, among other companies.

Mitarotonda began his career in operating positions at Bloomingdale's and Citibank and subsequently was co-founder, chairman, and CEO of Commonwealth Associates (now Comvest). He received a BA in economics from Queens College, where he currently serves as a member of the Board of Trustees, and an MBA from New York University's Stern School of Business.
