is a skilled plastic surgeon practicing all aspects of aesthetic, cosmetic, and reconstructive surgery. Kessler is certified by the American Board of Plastic Surgery and also has an additional credential from the Board of Plastic

Surgery with a Certificate of Added Qualification in Surgery of the Hand (1995–present). He has authored numerous scientific papers, including book chapters, and has presented at national and international conferences.

Kessler is currently the Chief of Plastic Surgery at South Nassau Community Hospital and is an Associate Clinical Professor of Plastic Surgery at the Weill Cornell Medical College in New York City. He is often sought for his professional advice by his colleagues and is listed as one of “New York’s Top Doctors” by Castle Connolly Medical Ltd., publisher of America’s top doctors.

He received his undergraduate degree from Queens College and graduated *summa cum laude*. He earned his medical degree from Cornell University Medical College where he was elected to the Alpha Omega Alpha medical honor society. He completed his plastic surgery training at the New York Hospital Cornell Medical Center and at the Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center in New York City.

Kessler has also completed additional fellowships in hand surgery and reconstructive microsurgery at the Cleveland Clinic and the University of Louisville Health Center respectively. His specialties include aesthetic, cosmetic and reconstructive breast surgery, facial rejuvenation, body contouring, and surgery of the hand. In addition, he has extensive plastic surgery experience with post-bariatric and weight-loss patients.
